By getting more consumers to report scammy solar companies, government officials said, they can more effectively track complaints and seek to hold accountable companies that violate the law.

Is solar panel fraud a global issue?

And while the aforementioned data focuses on the United States, solar panel fraud is a global issue. It is especially prevalent in Canada, where in the city of Calgary alone, the amount of applications for rooftop solar panels "has increased by nearly 600% since 2020," said the CBC.

How many complaints are there about solar-panel salespeople?

Meanwhile, consumer complaints about solar-panel salespeople have skyrocketed in recent years. The FTC received 5,331 complaints containing the phrase "solar panels" between Jan. 1 and Sept. 19 of 2023, up 31% from the entire year of 2022 and up 746% since 2018, when it received just 630 complaints.

How do I avoid a crappy solar panel deal?

To avoid a crappy solar panel deal, watch out for these scammy sales tactics. Dealing with door-to-door salespeople is annoying, no matter what they're selling. But the solar industry is full of bad actors, with solar salespeople knocking at your door with misleading offers and overpromised savings.

Do solar salesmen forged signatures?

(The federal incentive is actually a tax credit, so it comes in the form of a tax break, rather than a government check.) Other lawsuits allege that solar salesmen have forged signatures on electronic records or otherwise obscure what people are signing.

Are shady business practices hurting the solar market?

There have "been a lot of shady business practices in residential solar" that are "hurting the market," Micah Gold-Markel, the founder of the solar panel company Solar States, said to NPR.
